

Universal Three Way Thermostatic Diverter Valve Trim STYLE No. UN2TG1, UN2TM1, or UN2TR1 Universal Thermostatic Valve STYLE No. GUTH37, GUTH56, or GUTH78

IMPORTANT:

- > To ensure this product is installed properly, you must read and follow these guidelines.
- > The owner/user of this product must keep this information for future reference.
- This product can only be used with either the Universal Thermostatic Valve (GUTH37), the Universal 1/2" Thermostatic Valve (GUTH56) or the .25 Thermostatic Valve (GUTH78).
- > This valve requires a compatible wall valve trim and trim plate. ALL PRODUCTS SOLD SEPARATELY.
- This product, the thermostatic valve (GUTH37, GUTH56 or GUTH78) and the associated trims must be on-site prior to rough-in. This allows the installer to visualize the installation.
- Check incoming water pressure.
- > Inspect this product to assure you have all the parts required for proper installation.

Installation Guidelines


- Refer to the specification and assembly drawings attached. Product is sold partially assembled but shown fully disassembled for illustrative and service purposes only.
- This product must be installed by a professional licensed contractor. Ensure the installation conforms to all federal, state, and local codes. In the State of Massachusetts, all installations must comply with the rules and regulations set forth within 248 CMR.

FUNCTION:

- ➤ The Thermostatic Valves (GUTH37, GUTH56 and GUTH78) only mix hot and cold water, they do not have an on/off or volume control function. Mixed water flows out at a fixed volume to the diverter valve (GUDV14) which has 3 positions:
 - 2 that can direct water flow to a maximum of 2 devices. Water <u>cannot</u> flow out of the devices simultaneously (i.e. out of the shower head AND handshower together).
 - 1 position that shuts the water off to all devices.

ROUGH-IN:

Valve <u>rough-in depth</u> is measured from the centerline of the inlets to the surface of the finished wall, as shown below, and varies depending on the trim and paired thermostatic valve being used.




Universal Two Way Diverter Valve with Shutoff for Thermostatic Shower Systems

- Make sure the diverter valve is positioned according to the valve markings with the inlet port situated so that mixed water flows into the inlet.
- 2. Rough-in the diverter valve to an appropriate depth based on the trim being used and plumb to the desired devices.

NOTE: When the valve (GUDV14) is paired with the Universal Three way Diverter Valve Trim with Graphics (UN2TG1), it is crucial that the outlet ports are plumbed to specific devices: handshower and shower head. Reference the image below.




 The cartridge stem and threaded tube on the diverter valve can be cut to various lengths depending on the style of trim. Refer to the Installation Guidelines of individual trims for cutting dimensions and related information.



4. After the rough-in is completed, turn on the hot and cold supplies then check for leaks. Allow the water to run so the lines can be flushed completely.

- 5. Verify all the valves are functioning properly.
- 6. Attach the stem extension to the cartridge stem with the screw then install the tile guard.
