


- The screws on the escutcheons are aesthetic, do not \geq serve any mechanical purpose, and should not be removed.
- To ensure this product is installed properly, you must \geq read and follow these guidelines.
- \geqslant The owner/user of this product must keep this information for future reference.
- \triangleright This product must be installed by a professional licensed contractor. Be sure your installation conforms to federal state, and local codes. In the State of Massachusetts, all installations must comply with the rules and regulations set forth within 248 CMR.
- ≻ This product must be onsite prior to rough-in. This allows the installer to visualize the installation.
- \geq Wall valves (sold separately) control on/off/volume and must be installed for each fitting that will have water flowing to it. If using a wall valve with the Universal 1/2" Thermostatic Valve (Style No. GUTH56 - sold separately), refer to the Installation Guidelines for the Thermostatic Valve which contains related installation information.
- Inspect this product to ensure you have all the parts \geq required for proper installation.

Installation Guidelines

- Use only a strap wrench or protected/smooth-jaw \triangleright wrench on any finished surface.
- \triangleright DO NOT use putty. Putty contains oil and can cause permanent discoloration on certain materials such as marble, granite and any porous surface.

TRIM INSTALLATION:

Remove the tile guard and o-ring from the valve as 1. shown in Figure - 01.

- 2. Mark the threaded tube as shown in Figure 02 then remove and cut the thread tube.
- 3. Mark the cartridge stem as shown in Figure 02 then remove the cartridge and cut the cartridge stem
- 4. Thread the cartridge and threaded tube back onto the valve.
- 5. Thread the handle connector onto the threaded tube as shown in Figure 03, making sure the o-ring is securely in place.







 Slide the escutcheon up the handle stem to expose the threaded post at the base. With the handle in the desired orientation, place the handle stem onto the cartridge stem and thread the post into the handle connector until fully seated. Make sure to securely tighten the post. See Figure - 04.



Installation Guidelines

- Push the escutcheon against the finished wall and securely tighten the set screw using a 1/16" hex key. See Figure - 05.
- NOTE: If desired, a bead of caulk or a clear silicone may be applied where the ESCUTCHEON contacts the finished wall. DO NOT use putty.*



- 8. Turn on the water supply and operate the handle to ensure that it is functioning properly.
