Inspired by the Bradbury Building, an L.A. historic landmark built in 1892, this versatile ceramic tile assortment captures some of the rugged texture of glazed bricks in a more refined way. Handcrafted from fine red-body clay, the designs have a special artisanal edge and a slightly irregular surface that reflects light, amplifying each tile's unique color variation and depth. Choose from distinctive shades that lend themselves to uncommonly beautiful tonal blends, as well as dramatic large-scale architectural trims that transform a room.

### Installation / Maintenance

- WATERWORKS ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR INSTALLATION
- Installation constitutes acceptance.
- Tile should be installed by a licensed and experienced tile setter.
- Refer to TCNA (Tile Council of North America) or ANSI standards for installation guidelines.
- All tile must be inspected PRIOR to installation.
- Dry lay tile prior to installation to allow for blending of color variation.
- Tile should be sealed PRIOR to grouting. Dark grout can stain crackle tile.
- Waterworks recommends a grouted test panel prior to installation to understand final appearance of grouted materials
- Re-seal tile and grout after installation and maintain regularly.
